

One of Poland's largest commercial and entertainment complexes is located within the grounds of the former Izrael Poznański factory. Manufaktura houses over 300 shops, plenty of restaurants, two museums, a bowling alley, a climbing wall, a cinema and a hotel. The heart of Manufaktura is the market place, in which there is a city beach in the summer and an ice rink in the winter.
